We would like to invite you and any of your brass playing members to participate in a special event to commemorate the 100 year anniversary of the end of World War I.

As you may be aware, the RSL coordinates players to be placed at multiple intersections in the Perth CBD to play the Last Post at 11am on November 11th each year. This year, for the special occasion of the centenary, our vision is to have **one hundred buglers** participating in the commemoration in various locations throughout the Perth CBD, Kings Park and Northbridge on **Remembrance Day, Sunday November 11th 2018 at 11am**.

There are a limited number of instruments available for hire if anyone would like to join us who doesn't have the appropriate instrument available; e.g. you currently play euphonium, however are able to play trumpet and don't have your own. It would also be greatly appreciated that if you have spare instruments, if you would allow them to be loaned out for the occasion as we are expecting to attract a number of ex-servicemen who will need to borrow instruments.

It is important to note that we don't want to detract from other memorials on the day, if you are already assigned to make the bugle call at another location, we would ask that you attend that event as a priority.

We will be holding an information session on **Sunday 29th of July** and a rehearsal on **Sunday 7th of October at the DFES Training Academy in Forrestfield**, it is mandatory to attend these sessions to be able to participate. 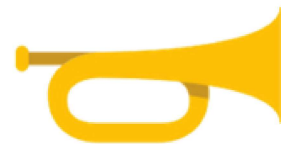

What is expected?

- We are accepting players of the following brass instruments:
 - Bugle
 - Trumpet
 - Cornet
 - Flugelhorn
- Each player will be assigned a location where they are to play, this will be within the Perth CBD, Kings Park or Northbridge.
- The pieces to be played are the *Last Post* and *Rouse*, sheet music will be provided as march card size so that you can attach it to your lyre.
- Players may be paired up if you are not comfortable with playing solo.
- You will need to look **sharp** by wearing your formal uniform or shirt and tie (jacket/blazer preferred)
- Instrument loans attract a \$100 bond that will be refunded upon return of the instrument in good, working order
